

Ski & meeting hotels in Austria

The **Austrian Alps** are a predestined location for **planning** exciting and original **incentives** as many ski resorts offer the fun aspect of the numerous **winter sport possibilities** as well as **meeting facilities**.

The hotels recommended in this newsletter all combine those two aspects perfectly and also offer **very good wellness** possibilities.

Furthermore the ski regions where those hotels are located are easy to reach via the international **airports** of **Munich, Zürich** and **Innsbruck** which all handle flights from Scandinavia on a regular basis.

Ötztal

The skiing region **Ötztal** which consists of **five resorts** impresses with its **great variety** of slopes (about 400 km altogether with 73 ski lifts), consistent **snow guarantee** and a long descent to the valley. Modern ski lifts secure a comfortable ascent to the tops. For snowboarders fun is guaranteed in the SWATCH snowpark Sölden or the fun park in Hochötz.

Besides the very good winter sport possibilities, the **après-ski opportunities** in the Ötztal are also **top-notch**.

The region is located in the Austrian state of **Tyrol**, about 90 km southeast of Innsbruck.



Hotel recommendations in Ötztal

Hotel Aqua Dome ****+

This **4 star superior hotel** is located in Längenfeld and offers a **spectacular view** over the Ötztal mountain region. It is well suited for MICE groups as it offers **7 meeting rooms** for up to 150 persons (classroom style) and is ideally located for a ski & meeting incentive.

Its **140 spacious rooms** are furnished after the feng shui concept. The in-house restaurants serve high-class dishes which combine **health cuisine** and **gourmet** joys from the region.

A large **thermal spa** is part of the hotel and offers spectacular architecture, several pools indoor and outdoor and an extensive **wellness** program.



Zell am See / Kaprun

The skiing resort Zell am See/Kaprun located in the heart of the **federal state Salzburg** and is the second biggest township of the area Pinzgau. **Salzburg airport** is about 90 km away while the distance to **Innsbruck airport** is about 150 km.

While skiing on the slope it is possible to enjoy the incredible panorama of the **Zeller See** and the **Kitzsteinhorn** (3.203 m). This is a **glacier** which means that one can ski here all around the year and even combine it with swimming in the Zeller See in the summertime.

Besides the **numerous winter sport possibilities**, the skiing region has also a good reputation in the **Après-Ski area**, offering an active **nightlife** and party scene for those who like to combine skiing and evening fun.



Hotel recommendations in Zell am See / Kaprun

Hotel Tauern Spa ****

This **4 star hotel** is located in Kaprun, with a wild romantic view over the nearby **Kitzsteinhorn** and close proximity to ski lifts which are about 1,0 km away.

This is a **large wellness & ski hotel** which also offers meeting facilities for up to **240 persons**. Its **160 rooms** are modernly furnished with light wood and colorful details. The very large **wellness area** (20.000 m²) includes high lights like a glass skyline pool, panorama saunas, steam baths and a chimney lounge. For culinary delights, 6 restaurants and bars offer their services.



Steigenberger Hotel Kaprun ****

This **4 star hotel** is located ideally for a skiing vacation as it lies in Kaprun, directly the **foot of the Kitzsteinhorn**. The Glacier Railway is just a few kilometers away from the hotel.

The hotel with its 125 rooms is an ideal residence for **sport and nature lovers**. The view from each of its balconies is a **panorama of mountains** and everlasting ice.

Swimming is possible both in winter and in summer as there are outdoor and indoor pools as well as a whirlpool. An **extensive sauna area**, a unique steam bath and a fitness area of 70 m² complete the wellness area.

The Steigenberger also offers **meeting facilities** for up to 55 people. The culinary needs of the guests are met by its **three restaurants** with international and regional specialties.



Saalbach Hinterglemm-Leogang

The skiing resort **Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang** is located south of **Salzburg**. The resort offers 55 lifts on 200 slope kilometers. It is one of Austria's **premier ski resorts**, offering a wide range of runs, extensive off piste, and an excellent snow record. Besides skiing, the Nitro snowpark is fantastic for skillful snowboarders. **Floodlight skiing** is also possible here.

Transfer time from Salzburg airport is about 90 minutes. Innsbruck airport is about 2 hours away from Saalbach and Munich airport nearly 3 hours. The resort is also well-known as the place where a lot of **après-ski partying** is happening.



Hotel recommendations in Saalbach-Hinterglemm

Alpenhotel Saalbach ****

Located in the centre of Saalbach, right beside the ski-lifts, the **4 star hotel** Alpenhotel combines Austrian coziness, nightlife experience and international cuisine.

With **96 rooms** furnished in country-style and 4 light meeting rooms for up to **170 persons** (classroom style) this hotel provides the perfect place for a **ski & meeting incentive**.

Several in-house restaurants offer dishes from the Asian, Italian & Mexican cuisine while the piano bar, the lounge and the night bar are the places to have some **nightlife** right at the hotel.

The **wellness area** consists of a pool, whirlpool, different types of saunas and a solarium. Relaxation after a day of skiing is guaranteed here.

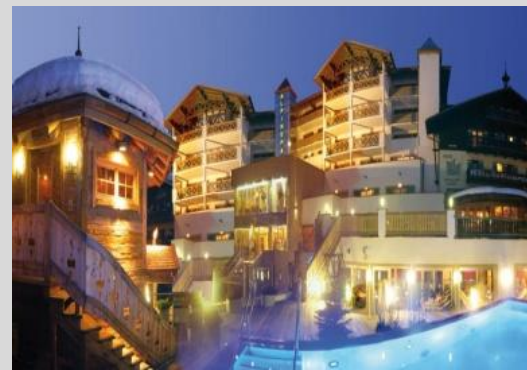


Hotel Alpine Palace *****

This **5 star hotel** is located in the centre of Hinterglemm, in short proximity to ski lifts which makes it the **perfect starting point** for weekends spent on the slopes. Besides its **82 nicely furnished rooms**, it also offers 4 meeting rooms for up to **220 persons** (classroom style), so here ski and meeting can be combined easily.

The in-house gastronomy includes several restaurants and bars and also a wine cellar which can be booked exclusively.

After a day in the snow, the **hotel's wellness area** (2.000 m²) with indoor and outdoor pools and sauna guarantees perfect relaxation.



Seefeld

The **Olympic winter sport region** Seefeld is a regular host for ski sport events, especially for Nordic skiing. Accordingly, it has great possibilities for **cross-country** (about 265 km with runs), but also **downhill slopes** (about 48 km with 32 ski lifts). Seefeld is particularly interesting as a ski **destination for families** as there are many activities suitable for children. On the other hand is the region not known for its après-ski either.

The skiing resort is located **very close** to **Innsbruck** which is only 25 km away, in the Tyrolean Alps.



Hotel recommendations in Seefeld

Bergresort Seefeld ****+

This idyllic **4 star superior hotel** with **84 spacious rooms** which are furnished in Tyrolean style is in close proximity to the skiing region. The next lift is only 1,2 km away, so the skiing fun can start right at the hotel.

Besides, the Bergresort houses good **meeting** possibilities and has 3 meeting rooms for up to **160 persons** (classroom style). So this is also a hotel where skiing and meeting can be easily combined.

Additionally the **wellness area** (1.400 m²) with a large swimming area, Kneipp basins, saunas and much more offers the ideal relaxation after an active day. **Culinary highlights** from the Tyrolean region are served in the in-house restaurant.



Hotel & Spa Royal Seefeld ****

This **4 star hotel** also combines the 3 elements skiing, meeting and wellness perfectly. The next ski lift is only about 0,5 km away, so all winter sport possibilities are easy to reach from here.

Besides its **126 classical furnished rooms**, the hotel also offers 6 meeting rooms for up to **100 persons** (classroom style). The in-house restaurants serve regional culinary delights.

The **wellness area** (3.500 m²) consists of several pools, a sauna landscape, a modernly equipped fitness area, a solarium and many aids to relax after an active day.
