

Innsbruck as a Ski & Winter incentive destination

The **Innsbruck area with the Tyrolean Alps** is a predestined location for **planning** exciting and original **incentives** as many ski resorts offer the fun aspect of the numerous **winter sport possibilities** as well as **meeting facilities**. Especially **Innsbruck** itself is the ideal place to **combine ski fun** with all the advantages of staying in a **city**.

Capacities over weekends

The huge advantage that it here is possible to get **allotments for weekends** as well as **SGL rooms**, something which is very difficult in other, classical, ski destinations.

Easy access via Munich airport

Furthermore the region is easy to reach via the international **airports** of **Munich** and **Innsbruck** which all handle flights from Scandinavia on a regular basis. Transfer time from Munich to Innsbruck is **approximately 2 hours**.

About Innsbruck

Innsbruck is located in the Inn valley between **high mountains** in **Tyrol**. Innsbruck is surrounded by several mountain chains with tops reaching a height of up to 3.500 m over sea level. This provides an impressive panorama for the city.

Innsbruck is a very internationally renowned **winter sport center**, and hosted **Winter Olympics** in 1964 and 1976. To the city's most important sights belongs the **Ski jump stadium** on the Bergisel, the imperial palace **Hofburg** and the **Triumphal Arch**. In the city centre one can find the well-known "**Goldenes Dachl**", a gold roof which is Innsbruck's landmark.

Besides having **many first-class** hotels with good **meeting facilities** and **group allotments** for weekends as well as a **varied selection** of **restaurants** ranging from rustic to first-class, the city offers a very special event location – the **Swarovski Crystal Worlds**. Here, the multi-faceted play of crystalline colors of the installations provides a **unique ambiance** for functions of 5 to 150 people.



The skiing region of Innsbruck

The **skiing region** of Innsbruck (the so-called Olympia Ski World) consists of **8 skiing regions** with 80 mountain railways and lifts and a total of 285 km of slopes.

Snow machines guarantee skiing until spring. There are **free ski busses** to all 8 ski resorts and from Innsbruck.

There is even a **lift connection** between the **city centre** and the **Hafelekarspitze** (2.269 m), the Nordkettenbahn which takes about **20 minutes** to reach the summit. There, **dinner events** can be held at 1.950 m, with a fantastic view of the surrounding mountaintops.

It is possible to purchase **one ski pass** for the whole Olympia Ski World of Innsbruck.



Nordpark Innsbruck (860 m – 2.269 m)

This skiing resort is the **closest to Innsbruck** and considered a real insider tip – because of the **Nordkettenbahn**, it is directly connected to the city.

Despite its rather small size, the resort offers a great **variety of possibilities**.

14 slope kilometers with 9 lifts, the “**Skylinepark**” for snowboarders with its panoramic view over Innsbruck and the very steep **Hafelekarrinne** for skilled skiers are among the highlights here. There are also possibilities to arrange **company races** and events of all kinds.



Stubai Glacier (1.750 m – 3.333 m)

This is the **largest** skiing region in the Innsbruck area: **110 km** with slopes, divided into 4 skiing areas, with 21 lift installations, offer possibilities for every taste and abilities.

The **snow guarantee** from October to June because of the glacier provide for great conditions nearly all around the year.

Here, skiers can take a break in **Austria's highest restaurant** and enjoy the breathtaking view over the mountain surroundings.

The skiing resort is located about **40 km** from Innsbruck.



Axamer-Lizum (1.583 m - 2.340 m)

This is also a rather **large skiing resort** in the Innsbruck area. Because of its height of up to 2.340 m over sea level, there is a very good **snow guarantee** for this resort.

Ten modern lift installations and over **40 km of slopes** of various difficulties in combination with the **brehtaking panorama** make the Axamer-Lizum one of the best resorts in the area.

The distance to Innsbruck is ca. **18 km**.



Schlick2000 (1.000 m – 2.300 m)

This **many-sided** skiing resort is located at the beginning of the Stubai valley, about **25 km** away from Innsbruck.

The **22 slope kilometers** with 11 lift installations offer something for everybody, beginners or experts, families or après-ski lovers.

Besides skiing slopes, the **Schlick2000** also has possibilities for paragliding and hang gliding, tobogganing and other winter activities.
